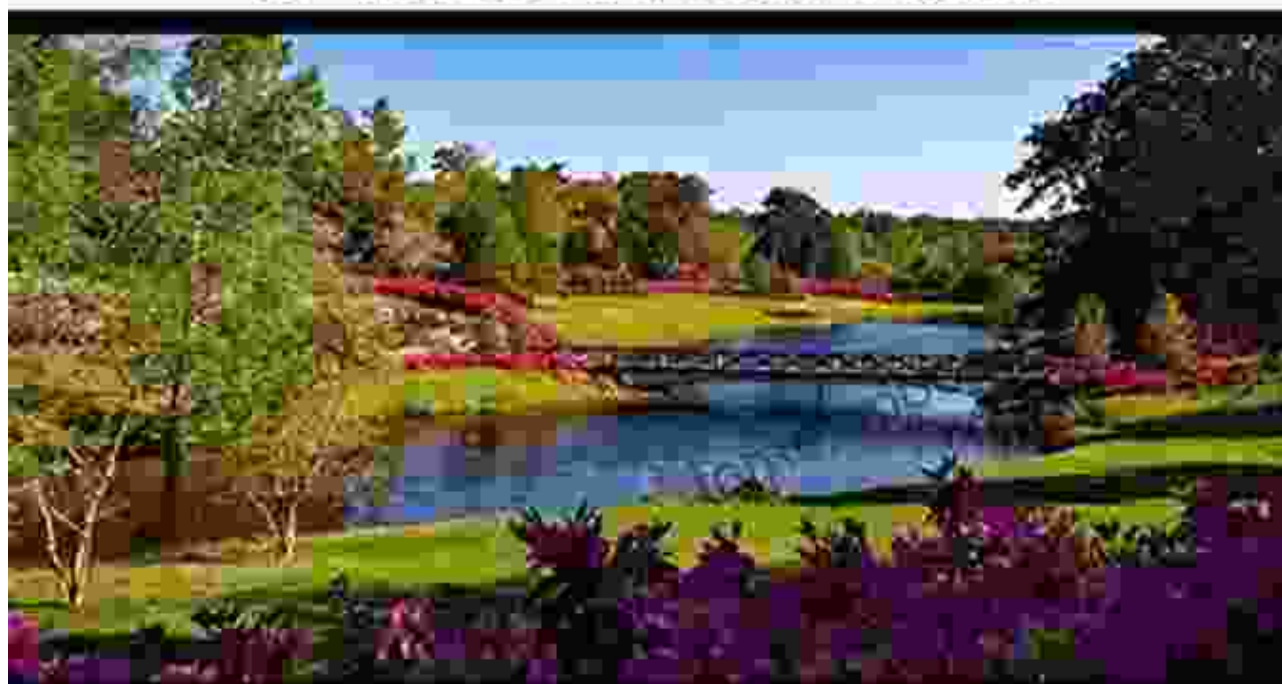

- **The Birmingham Barons** are a Minor League Baseball team that plays at Regions Field. The Barons are a fun and affordable way to enjoy a night out.







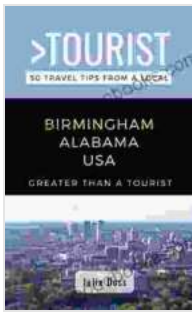
Getting Around Birmingham

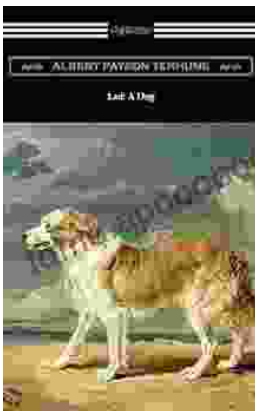
